Museum Passport: how it works

- The passport is distributed free of charge at museum network member sites.
- It is valid for 2 adults, and there is no expiry date.
- Reduced entry is available from your second visit onwards.
- At the 4th, 8th and 12th sites you visit, entry is free.
- Don't forget to have your passport stamped at each museum you visit.
